IMPORTANT INFORMATION – MAJOR WORKS STARTING AT B4114/LEICESTER LANE, ENDERBY.

Works to improve the B4114/Leicester Lane junction and construct a new access junction on Leicester Lane will begin on 19th September 2016, with advance works to set up a compound off Leicester Lane from 12th September 2016.

The first phase of these works, which will last approximately 12 weeks, will see lane closures on the B4114 and the closure of the left turn from the B4114 (city bound) in to Leicester Lane. Traffic will be diverted via Everards roundabout to B4114 south to make the right turn into Leicester Lane. The works are expected to finish Spring 2017 and you will be notified in advance of changes in traffic management.
