**This is a transcript of a Police Message sent to Primary Schools:**

**'We know that many children are using social media when 'officially' they are too young to sign up to the sites—we know because they tell us!**

**Lots of them say that their mums and dads have signed them up—sometimes years ago. There's nothing illegal in that, but please keep in mind that if you signed your 8 year old up to Facebook five years ago, saying they were 13 years old—they now appear as an 18 year old on the site.**

**If an adult tries to groom your now 13 year old via social media, they will be able to argue that they thought they were talking to another adult. Remember to update your child's details, check their privacy settings and talk to them about which pictures they use for their profile, so they're safe online.'**
