UNIFORM POLICY

Clothing

Red sweat shirt cardigan or jumper. Logo where possible

Red or white polo shirt.

Grey trousers or skirt.

Tops with hoods and jeggings are not allowed.

Summer

Red & white summer dress.

Grey shorts

Footwear

Black shoes

Black trainers which must not be branded.

Boots are not allowed however children can wear them to school and change into black plimsolls or shoes if desired.

Hair

Long hair should be tied up. For health and safety reasons staff will ask children to put their hair into bands if they come to school with it loose.

Hair decorations should be minimal.

Mohican or similar distinctive haircuts are not suitable for the learning environment, parents will be allowed to a meeting with senior staff if children arrive in school with inappropriate haircuts. Bright dyed hair is not acceptable

Jewellery

Jewellery is not allowed. If ears are newly pierced earrings must be covered with micropore tape during P.E.
