

## An update from Miss Lawrence (Headteacher) and Mrs Hickinbottom (Deputy)...

We hope that you have had a fantastic Christmas and are ready to start 2020. We are looking forward to looking at what the children achieve in 2020. There are many different announcements and pieces of information to share with you already:

### New KS2 entrance

We have already sent an email to detail the new arrangements for the opening of our new KS2 entrance, but there will be some changes to drop off and home time arrangements:

\*Year 5 and 6 will enter and exit through the new entrance independently. Adults will not be able to enter through this new entrance. The office will be able to support if you need to get messages to teachers.

\*EYFS—Year 4 will enter through the other entrance. Adults will still not be permitted to enter classrooms in KS2. The office will be able to support if you need to get messages to teachers. EYFS—Year 2 will continue to have an open door policy. The gates will still shut at 09:05 and all adults must have exited by then. There will be no option to come through the main building anymore to ensure that there are no unattended adults in the building.

\*EYFS—Year 2 will be picked up as usual after school.

\*Year 3 will now be picked up from the same playground as Year 1 and 2.

\*Year 4 will now be picked up from outside the classrooms.

**Members of the Senior Leadership Team will be on hand to help direct you to where you need to drop off and pick up so if you are unsure then please just ask one of us :-)**
