Child Protection Statement

Danemill Primary School fully recognises the contribution it can make to protect children and support pupils in school. The aim is to safeguard and promote our pupils' welfare, safety and health by fostering an honest, open, caring and supportive climate. The pupils' welfare is of paramount importance.

There are four main elements to our Child Protection Policy:

Prevention – By creating a positive school atmosphere, providing teaching and pastoral support to pupils and implementing safer recruitment procedures

Protection – By ensuring staff follow agreed procedures and are trained and supported to respond appropriately and sensitively to Child Protection concerns

Support – By ensuring support is available to pupils and school staff and to children who may have been abused

Working with parents - To ensure appropriate communications and actions are undertaken

We recognise that Child protection is the responsibility of all who use the school
