Your child will be studying the following areas:

- English: discussion and debate; letters to persuade and inform; narrative.
  - Mathematics: fractions, decimals and percentages; geometry and position; perimeter and area.
  - Science: Light.
  - PSHE: Key values; relationships; community; charity.
  - Computing: Kodu and E-safety day.
  - Indoor P.E Tuesdays – dance
