Everyone must apply for a school place as there is no automatic entry for any school. Before you apply for your child's school place for September 2023, please make sure the following applies to you (for Leicestershire Secondaries only):

- 1. You live in Leicestershire.
- 2. Your child is eligible to start secondary school in September 2023 e.g. was born between 1 September 2011 and 31 August 2012 inclusive
- 3. You know what school you would like your child to go to.
- 4. You know how your child will get to school.


