




Phonics Support


We have been learning out Phase 2 sounds. Please practice these at home with your child. You can also consolidate these by scanning the QR codes to access Bug Club and Phonics Play.



Top tips for reading at home with your child.

- Please read the book more than once with your child.
- Ask your child lots of questions about the book.
- Read lots of different types of books with your child e.g. stories and factual books.
- Ask your child to re-tell the story in their own words, describing the characters and the setting.
- Make up stories at home by having a start, a middle and an end.





Maths Learning Support Please practice number recognition and formation to 5. 4 Wider Curriculum Our topic this half-term is 'Why do we celebrate?' so it would be lovely to talk to your child about lots of different celebrations.
