











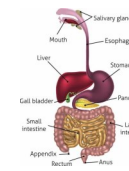

Top tips for reading at home with your child

Please encourage your child to read their AR book (and other books that they enjoy) at home. Don't forget to fill out their yellow reading diary as this will earn them prizes! They can then complete their AR quiz at school and change their book.

Encourage your child to use expression when they are reading, especially for the voices of the different characters.

Talk to them or ask them questions about what they have read to see if they have understood the information. Have a go at making some predictions together 'what will happen next?' and 'what makes you think that?'

Discuss the meaning of words. Use a dictionary (can be digitally) or get your child used to exploring the word for themselves. Try discussing alternative words. For example 'big' ask your child another word that means the same like 'huge'.

Sometimes it's a good idea for you to read to your child so they can hear how you read.

Maths Learning Support

Practice their times tables through chanting or quizzing them. Also, giving your child time to access Times Table Rock Stars as we have a tournament each week with the other Year 4 class to see which class can earn the most points.

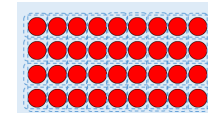
In addition to times tables to help your children with your 4 basic operations you can give them different questions. Here are examples of how they will be learning to work them out in class so the same format is being followed.

Addition: $2,151 + 4,312 = 6,463$
