### Top tips for reading at home with your child.

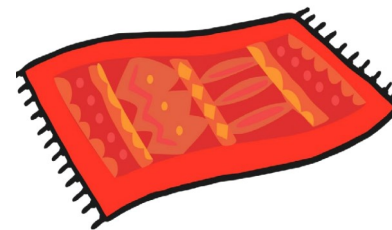
- Please read the book more than once with your child.

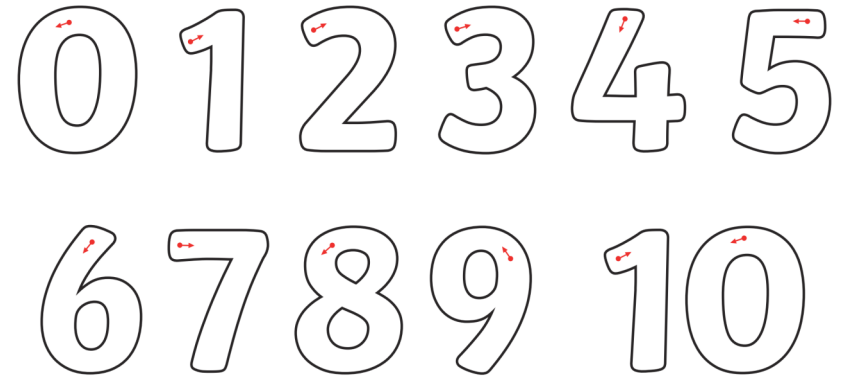
