Date: 2nd July **Time:** Morning session (9am-11am) **Location:** EYFS Classrooms

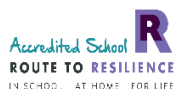
We encourage children to join us for a morning in the EYFS classrooms to experience a typical day in our Early Years setting. They will have the chance to participate in activities within the EYFS setting.
