Holi Festival Dance Workshop – Thursday 5th June 2025

As part of this celebration, it is a tradition to throw different coloured powdered paints. These paints are provided by the dance company and are non-toxic, very safe and will wash away. There will also be an opportunity for parents and carers to join in and throw the colours too! If you would like your child to participate in the colour throwing, please ensure that your child brings in a change of clothing, (which you do not mind being covered with the paints).

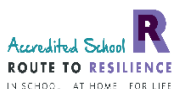
