

Curriculum Information for the 1st Half of the Autumn Term 2020 – Year 2

Our topic is called **Towers, Tunnels and Turrets!**



Your child will be studying the following areas:

English: Narratives – Shrek, Brave, recounts, explanation texts and instructions

Grammar: simple sentence structures, word groups/families, nouns, verbs, adjectives, prefixes and suffixes, singular and plural, punctuation – exclamation marks, question marks, conjunctions, common exception words spellings.

Maths: Place value, addition and subtraction

ICT: E-Safety and basic computer skills.

Science: Materials and working scientifically.

History: Danemill Day, significant individuals: Richard III, William the Conqueror, history of castles and their purpose, Warwick Castle.

PSHCE: British Values and the schools Characteristics (*curiosity, collaboration, communication, reflection, resilience, bravery, motivation and creativity*), friendships and belonging.

Art: Using a range of materials and techniques: castle silhouettes, family crests, dragon painting, using shapes to create art.

RE: Special celebrations, Christianity

DT: Mechanisms and structures – make a castle with moving drawbridge.

PE: Rounders, netball and basketball
